Notification of Rights under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act For Elementary and Secondary Schools

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) affords parents and students over 18 years of age ("eligible students") certain rights with respect to the student's education records. These rights are:

(1) The right to inspect and review the student's education records within 45 days of the day the School receives a request for access.

Parents or eligible students should submit to the School principal (or appropriate school official) a written request that identifies the record(s) they wish to inspect. The School official will make arrangements for access and notify the parent or eligible student of the time and place where the records may be inspected.

(2) The right to request the amendment of the student's education records that the parent or eligible student believes are inaccurate.

Parents or eligible students may ask the School to amend a record that they believe is inaccurate. They should write the School principal (or appropriate school official), clearly identify the part of the record they want changed, and specify why it is inaccurate. If the School decides not to amend the record as requested by the parent or eligible student, the School will notify the parent or eligible student of the decision and advise them of their right to a hearing regarding the request for amendment. Additional information regarding the hearing procedures will be provided to the parent or eligible student when notified of the right to a hearing.

(3) The right to consent to disclosures of personally identifiable information contained in the student's education records, except to the extent that FERPA authorizes disclosure without consent.

One exception, which permits disclosure without consent, is disclosure to school officials with legitimate educational interests. A school official is a person employed by the School as an administrator, supervisor, instructor, or support staff member (including health or medical staff and law enforcement unit personnel); a person serving on the School Board; a person or company with whom the School has contracted to perform a special task (such as an attorney, auditor, medical consultant, or therapist); or a parent or student serving on an official committee, such as a disciplinary or grievance committee, or assisting another school official in performing his or her tasks.

A school official has a legitimate educational interest if the official needs to review an education record in order to fulfill his or her professional responsibility.

(4) The right to file a complaint with the U.S. Department of Education concerning alleged failures by the School District to comply with the requirements of FERPA. The name and address of the Office that administers FERPA are:

Section 504/ADA Policy Notice

The Midland Park School District does not discriminate on the basis of disability with regard to admission, access to services, treatment, or employment in its programs or activities.

Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 prohibits discrimination against individuals with disabilities in any program receiving federal financial assistance. The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) applies to employers who have over 14 employees regardless of federal financial assistance. Under both Acts, the definition of an "individual with a disability" is a person who:

1. has a mental or physical impairment which substantially limits one or more major life activities, such as seeing, hearing, speaking, breathing, learning, or working; or
2. has a record of such impairment; or
3. is regarded as having such an impairment

The District will evaluate, identify, and provide free appropriate education to all students who are individuals with disabilities under Section 504 or the ADA. Parents of these students are entitled to procedural safeguards, including individual notice and an impartial hearing.

The District will provide reasonable accommodation to each employee and qualified employment applicant covered by Section 504 or the ADA consistent with its legal obligations toward any program involved.

The District will furnish auxiliary aids and services to students, employees, parents, and members of the public who have disabilities to the extent necessary for communication with other persons, unless it will result in an undue burden on, or a fundamental alteration in the program.

The District has a grievance procedure for disability discrimination complaints. For a description of this procedure, or any further relevant information, including the District's updated self-evaluation, contact the building Principal.

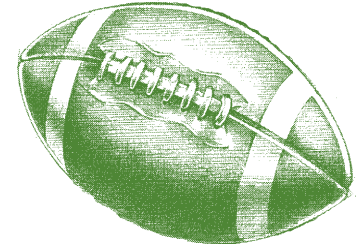

Interscholastic Athletics Student Participation and Eligibility

Maximum participation in interscholastic athletics by girls and boys in accordance with interest, maturity, and ability to benefit is to be encouraged. Wherever the availability of facilities, coaching personnel, and budget permits, a "no-cut" policy is desirable.

To be eligible for athletic competition during the first semester (September 1 to January 31) of the 10th grade or higher, or the second year of attendance in the secondary school or beyond, a pupil must have passed 25% of the credits (27.5) **[30 beginning with the Class of 2014]** required by the State of New Jersey for graduation (110) **[120 beginning with the Class of 2014]**, during the immediately preceding academic year.

To be eligible for athletic competition during the second semester (Feb. 1 to June 30) of the 9th grade or higher, a pupil must have passed the equivalent of 12 1/2% of the credits (13.75) **[15 beginning with the Class of 2014]** required by New Jersey for graduation (110) **[120 beginning with the Class of 2014]** at the close of the preceding semester (Jan. 31). Full-year courses shall be equated as one-half of the total credits to be gained for the full year to determine credits passed during the immediately preceding semester.

In an effort to develop standards which are fair to all students, a review board will be established. The purpose of this review board is to hear appeals from students who are below established criteria, and are seeking continued participation in interscholastic sports.

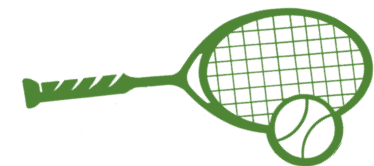
