SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Presentation of the proposed 2013-2014 School Budget and Public Hearing Dr. Cirasella and Mr. Schiffer presented a power point

demonstration on the proposed school budget for the 2013-2014 year.

## Open to the Public

Mr. Sullivan invited the public to address the Board.

Demitri Pittas questioned what would happen if the 2<sup>nd</sup> question fails. Mr. Schiffer answered that the three partial roof replacements listed would not be done. Ms. Garvey added there is money in the general fund budget for the replacement of a small section of the high school roof.

Ms. Colleen Monahan questioned how long does a roof last and asked about the sections that were completed in 2004. Mr. Schiffer answered that they could last up to fifteen to twenty years, so in 2019 we may be looking at those sections again. There are always problems with flat roofs.

Mr. Judd Seals asked if the second question does not pass then can those same items be put into a referendum vote. Mr. Schiffer answered that they could not be brought before the public for one year.

Ms. Therese Connors asked which section was going to be completed at the high school and stated that she remembers a lot of leaks in certain sections while she was employed by the district. Mr. Schiffer explained that the sections being done are in the worse condition, although every section is leaking.

Mr. Donald Togneri asked the total number of additions to the staff.

Dr. Cirasella responded that it will be .5 teaching load spread over multi people and a district technology coordinator. Mr. Togneri also asked where these positions were budgeted.

Ms. Garvey responded that the teaching positions were budgeted under Regular Programs and technology position is in Media and Technology.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Midland Park Board of Education, County of Bergen, approves the final 2013-2014 school year budget, as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the GENERAL FUND tax levy \$17,847,884 is approved to support Current General Expense and \$423,472 to support Debt Service, for the 2013/2014 school year budget.

and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That there should be raised an additional \$955,075.00 for General Funds in the same school year (2013-2014). These taxes will be used exclusively for partial roof replacement projects for Godwin School, Highland School and Midland Park Junior/Senior High School. Approval of these taxes will not result in a permanent increase in the district's tax levy. These proposed additional expenditures are in addition to those necessary to achieve the Core Curriculum Content Standards.
