Resolution to Approve the 2013-2014 School Year Budget

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Midland Park Board of Education, County of Bergen, approves the final 2013-2014 school year budget, as follows:

Current General Expense (Funds 11)	\$19,453,554
Capital Outlay (Fund 12)	\$ 137,617
Extended School Year Program (Fund 13)	\$ 698,839
TOTAL GENERAL FUND	\$20,290,010
Special Revenue (Fund 20)	\$ 444,370
TOTAL DEBT SERVICE FUND	\$ 423,669
 TOTAL EXPENDITURES/APPROPRIATIONS	 \$21,158,049

and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the GENERAL FUND tax levy \$17,847,884 is approved to support Current General Expense and \$423,472 to support Debt Service, for the 2013/2014 school year budget.

and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That there should be raised an additional \$955,075.00 for General Funds in the same school year (2013-2014). These taxes will be used exclusively for partial roof replacement projects for Godwin School, Highland School and Midland Park Junior/Senior High School. Approval of these taxes will not result in a permanent increase in the district's tax levy. These proposed additional expenditures are in addition to those necessary to achieve the Core Curriculum Content Standards.
